Gokwe Dairy Farmers Cooperative Society Limited 3016-ZWE	2014-2018	\$246,126	Sector: Agriculture (Dairy) Town/City: Kwekwe Summary: The project funds will be used to help the association grow its business through production of good quality milk by increasing herd size, membership, production, knowledge and marketing.
Tony Waite Organization 4083-ZWE	2015-2018	\$222,200	Sector: Agriculture (Dried Fish) Town/City: Kariba, Mashonaland West Province Summary: The project funds will be used to increase the group's production of dried Kapenta and improve and expand marketing efforts. The funds will allow for the purchase of three fishing boats, construction of a processing factory and procurement and installation of a packing line. The funds will also be used to support income generating activities and employment for women and youth.

DDFACS promotes the economic and social interests of the members through profitable collective dairy production and marketing. Domboshawa's locality and surrounding suburbs have unmet demand for milk.

CONSTANCE KARORO Coco Seed Culture	2017-2018	\$10,000	Sector: Textiles Location: Harare Summary: With the funds provided by this grant, Coco Seed Culture will establish the first Cut Make Trim (CMT) production house in Zimbabwe allowing independent designers to produce minimum quantity orders, digitize their designs and patters, foster collaboration, and achieve viable scale and consistent quality of their work. Coco Seed Culture's investment in the equipment and tools necessary for such a production house will allow them to offer their services to even more clients than before and serve as a pilot for possible expansion elsewhere on the continent. This inclusive model allows independent designers to retain the rights to their work while at the same time being able to offer their designs to a larger global market.
